New Haven Connecticut-Thomas Papcin has pled guilty in the US District Court of Connecticut to mail fraud as part of his counterfeit coupon activities. According to the Plea agreement, he faces a maximum term of twenty years in prison; three years of supervised release, a fine of \$250,000, and restitution.
